Part A :

What is the plan of action chalked out by the IQAC in the beginning of the year towards quality enhancement & what is the outcome by the end of the year ?

Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college met on 16th April, 2008. Resolutions in the form of following suggestions were passed.

1. Feed back from parents / guardians of students with the help of a questionnaire –
Looking to the very poor response of the parents / guardians to our appeal for meetings, it was suggested that questionnaires be prepared and sent to them through their wards. An effective brief appeal be sent along with, explaining the role of the parents into the overall development of their wards & request them to come forward & co-operate with us in this mission.
2. Preparation of time bound mission document. –
Members of the IQAC vehemently requested the Management to prepare a time bound mission document in which Sports, Laboratories and Library find prominent place.
3. Request to authorities for increase in FSI –
Members resolved that there is an urgent need of approaching the authorities by the Management with the request of increasing the F.S.I. of the college & the same be used to increase the space for Laboratories and the Library. Alternate space be explored for sports activities.
4. Philip in Extension Activities –
Members advised that social activities by the students need to be given a Philip. Pressing problems in the adopted area may be identified and possible corrective measures be taken.

5. Process of Re-accreditation to be initiated –

Members suggested that the process of Re-accreditation be initiated 'Letter of Intent' be submitted and working on preparation of RAR I & II be started.

Thus the resolutions underline the action-plan chalked out by the IQAC.

Action initiated on the suggestions made by IQAC is as follows :

1. Suggestion as regards preparation of Questionnaires and sending them to the parents / guardians of students was implemented. Very substantial information by way of suggestions and feedback has been received. This year's feedback is reported as the answer to question 30 in part B of this report.
2. The management is working on the mission document despite constraint of space.
3. Extension activities have been given more attention this year as is visible from the report in response the Question no. 17 in part B of this report.
4. Yes, 'Letter of Intent' was submitted to NAAC, Bangalore on 28/8/2008 & work of preparation of RAR I & II has been initiated.

Part B :

1. Activities reflecting the goals & objectives of the Institution :

The following activities were undertaken in the academic year 2008-2009, which reflect the goals and objectives of the institution as well.

- i. N.S.S students, besides their regular activities and camps, concentrated on environment related activities . The students adopted a village on the eve of “Ganesh Festival” and vehemently explained to the folks the hazards of preparing Ganesh idols using Plaster of Paris and poisonous synthetic dyes and their subsequent emersion in water bodies in the village.The villagers were persuaded to use clay for the purpose. Besides the villagers were educated regarding disposal of “ Nirmalya” produced as a result of the worship on the occasion.
- ii. Another significant activity by the NSS students was to have a rally on the eve of “AIDS day” in village Takarkheda and enact street plays on the way to send across a message. AIDS awareness programme was also held in the college by NSS with the help of authorities from Civil Hospital, Jalgaon.
- iii. NCC students continued to have their regular parades, camps and celebrations. Besides some students showed promising results on other fronts like participation in Thal Sainik Camp,National Integration Camp,Group Selection Training Camp, Inter Group Competition DTE Selection Camps, RD group Selection Camp etc. Our NCC cadets flourished on other fronts too. 08 students passed “B” certificate examination and 07 cadets passed “C” certificate examination.
- iv. Besides, many activities by the Art Circle, Debating Club, Spoken English Course, Computer Literacy & Internet Course all together help the institution in fulfilling our goal.
- v. Questionnaires were got filled up by parents to gather information about their assessment regarding various functions of the college through their interaction

with their wards. Besides gathering of the parents of our students was arranged & a fruitful interaction took place. Analysis of the feedback was done & the information that surfaced was presented before the management.

- vi. 'Certificate course in spoken English' & 'Computer Literacy & Internet Course' were continued to be conducted this year as well. This is open to all desirous students from all faculties.
- vii. Annual Social Gathering & the welcome party continue to be a star attraction & do a lot of good to the student community. Both these events are fully managed by the students without any flaw.
- viii. Feed back about all the aspects concerning the students in the college including their teachers, continues to be taken. This has helped the system to remain healthy & grow.

2. New academic programmes initiated (UG & PG) :

Post Graduate Courses in Economics part II, Computer Science Part II & Commerce Part II have been introduced from this Year.

Under Graduate course in Computer Application (BCA) has also been introduced.

3. Innovations in curricular design and transaction :

Ours is an affiliated college. The syllabi for all streams is framed by the University. However our college teachers regularly contribute by attending syllabus framing workshops whenever conducted by the University. During the year 2008-09, 17 teachers attended such workshops to restructure and update syllabi in their respective subjects.

7. Total number of seminars / workshops conducted :

1) Seminar on “Global Warming” :

A one day University level Seminar was conducted on Jan. 12th , 2009 on “Global Warming”. Dr. B.L.Chavan, Reader, Dept. of Environment, Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Marathwada University, inaugurated the Seminar, while Ad. H.A.Chaudhari, President, Lewa Educational Union, Jalgaon presided over the function. Prof. Dr. V.J. Patil co-ordinated the Seminar. Prof. Dr. S.B. Chincholkar, Director, BCUD, North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon was the Chief Guest for the Valedictory. Prin. Dr. D.D. Narkhede was in the Chair.

45 participants presented Research Papers while total 145 Teachers from various colleges participated actively in the Seminar. A poster exhibition on “Global Warming” was also arranged.

2) Workshop on “Changes in Higher Education”

A workshop on “Changes in Higher Education” was held on 1st March 2009 in the Dhande Sabhagruh on behalf the North Maharashtra University, Jalgaon, to enlighten the teachers from the local colleges on the issues like the Recommendations of the National Knowledge Commission, Bar Code method, Credit Points and Grading System. Prin. Dr. D.D. Narkhede was in the chair. Prof. B.P. Savakhedkar, Prof. Dr. R.T. Potdar, Prof. J.D. Lekurwale were the resource persons. 22. Number of courses for which student assessment of teacher is introduced and the action taken on student feedback :

The process of assessment of the teachers by the students was introduced in the academic year 2002-03 It continues till date. The feed back is obtained through a questionnaire. It is done by a committee framed for the purpose. The results obtained are presented to the Principal who holds individual sessions with concerned teachers wherever necessary. It is taken in the right spirit by all the teachers to introduce some improvements in teaching and learning process.

24. Computerization of administration and the process of admissions and examination results, issue of certificates :

During the year 2008-09 ,the MKCL through the North Maharashtra University ,Jalgaon has provided software for process of admissions and examination results. However, the college has been in MOU with the Techno-soft Solution (erstwhile SMC Technologies) for the administrative & Library work through computerization. Hence an annual maintenance contract with the

same Institute was reached at to upgrade the software and solve the day-to-day problems in its use.

25. Increase in infra structural facilities :

- 1) Model Class room with modern audio visual aids was developed.
- 2) Assembly hall named "Dhande Sabhagruh" was built up.
- 3) Additional urinal units for male & female teachers, students on the campus were made available.
- 4) Additional Computer Laboratory was developed for PG students.

26. Technology up-gradation :

- 1) 17 Computers were added to the present no. of computers.
- 2) Computer with 128 MB RAM capacity were upgraded to 256 MB RAM.
- 3) For maintenance of the College Website, an MOU with the Santronix Computers, Jalgaon.
- 4) 30 KVA Diesel Generator was purchased to have backup for the office, computer & other departments during load shading.

27. Computer and internet access and training to teachers and students :

Computer Science Department of the college regularly conducts "Computer Literacy & Internet Programme" for the benefit of students & teachers. This year the Dept. conducted "Internet Literacy Course" for 03 batches, each batch consisting of 15 participants.

28. Financial aid to students :

Besides exemption of fees to students under various schemes of government a novel scheme titled, "Earn & Learn" continues to run in the college. Economically challenged students are identified and assigned some job in the library, college office and laboratories. The timing is so adjusted that normal college schedule of the students is not disturbed. This year 37

students got benefited under the scheme. An amount of Rs. 96260 /- was spent for the purpose.

29. Activities and support from the Alumni Association :

During the year under report a membership registration campaign was implemented with a result of 90 ex-students of the college accepting the membership and promising to actively participate in the activities of Alumni Association.

A guidance lecture of Ms. Vijaya Rane was organized for the benefit of the participants of the Chanakya Spardha Pariksha guidance sub-centre of the college. While Mrs. Saroj Badgular, an Alumnae of this college delivered a lecture for the students of the psychology department. Miss. Sonal Shah, who is a Judge at Amaravati visited the department of English and expressed satisfaction over the functioning of the Language lab.

A major break for the ex-students was given in the Annual Social Gathering 2008-09 Miss. Manjula Mundada, Vaishali Warde, Hirkani Patil, Jyoti

Joshi, Jaya Nikumbh, Poonam Nikumbh and Miss. Dipali Kadam presented their performances in gathering.

30. Activities and support from the Parent – Teacher association :

The committee organized a campaign to create an awareness amongst the students about the educational programs and co-curricular activities on the campus through getting filled questionnaires from the 2nd and 3rd year students. Similarly the committee tried to know the opinions of the parents about the problems of students while they are on the campus. From the Science faculty 143, from the Commerce faculty 134 and from the Arts faculty 251 students helped the committee to get the responses of their parents through the questionnaire.

On 14th February 2009 the committee organized 'Sahavichar Sabha' with the parents. The parents, teachers, HOD's and the Principal had a dialogue which revealed the expectations of the students regarding Academic facilities on the campus, Competitive Examination guidance, Computer facilities and Library services. Prin. Dr. D.D. Narkhede made a presidential address in which he appealed the parents to co-operate with the institution so as to bring better results as far as their wards are concern.

31. Health Services :

A modest health centre is operational in the college. 04 doctors are on call. Besides there are 02 doctors on staff in the college whose services are availed during college hours as and when needed.

A committee has been constituted in the college from amongst the teachers which monitors hygienic conditions in the canteen, overall sanitation etc. along with Medical Checkup programme for first year students. During this year the Medical checkup programme was held during 11-13th September 2008 for the first year students.



Part C :

Explain the plans of the institution for the next year :

Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college met on 25th April 2009. resolutions in the form of following suggestions were passed. The members also took notice of the inferences from the feedback obtained from the students with the help of a questionnaire & also the feedback received through two suggestion boxes & feedback from the guardians /parents.

- i) It was suggested that a building on 3000 sq.feet area, adjacent to the college building that is on sale, be acquired. The FSI so gained be used for construction of a building for primary school. This will relieve pressure on the main campus to some extent.
- ii) Management must prepare a master plan of at least coming 10 years.
- iii) Teachers must be encouraged to take up research activities in the form of Minor and Major Research projects.
- iv) Possibility of extension of library be probed. Improvement in the reference section be made.
- v) Re-accreditation process be actively pursued. Report writing and other related activities be taken at a faster pace.
- vi) Working in the library and office need to be fully computerized. Any short comings reported in the software be immediately got rectified by the concerned personnel.
- vii) A committee be framed that would make suggestions and help in their implementation regarding campus beautification.



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
