Report on Katha Smarakanchya (Stories of Monuments)

Name of the Programme: *Katha Smarakanchya* (Stories of Monuments) Organising unit/collaborating agency: Dr.A.G.D.B.M.M.College, and KBCNMU,Jalgaon

Brief Summary of the Programme:

The Jalgaon district holds a significant place in India's struggle for independence. Its contribution to the movement is evident through the numerous monuments that stand tall even today. The Jyoti Memorial, brought on foot from Mumbai by the revered Sane Guruji and his followers, still stands in Faizpur, where the first rural session of the Indian Congress was held in 1936. Amalner, the hub of the independence movement in Khandesh, houses the memorial of Khaja Naik, who was martyred during the August Revolution of 1942. The tomb of Khaja Naik, who revolted against the British during the Revolt of 1857 in the Satpura Hill ranges of Khandesh, can be found in Dharangaon. However, as time passes, these monuments and their historical significance have been forgotten. To shed light on this forgotten history, the mass media department of the college and KBCNMU, Jalgaon collaboratively produced a documentary titled 'Katha Smarakanchya' (Stories of Monuments). The film aims to explore these monuments and unravel the history surrounding them. Headed by Prof. Santosh Sonawane, the electronic media department, along with the students and faculty of the photography and videography department, conducted extensive research and filming for this project.
