Title of the Practice - Motivation through Financial Support

(Student Welfare Fund)

1. Objectives and Practice –

- A. To assist financially challenged students and to enhance their academic performance.
- B. To motivate meritorious students by awarding cash prizes.

2. The Context - Due to economical instability, many students avoid pursuing higher education. Higher education reflects the progress of a country, so such a scheme is needed to attract students to higher education

3. Practice - Under SWC of the college, teaching and non-teaching staff donate Rs 1000 or 500 to the committee on their birthdays. This amount is deposited in the bank account of needy students or students who have secured good ranks in the annual examination. This year a total fund of 73372/- Rs.

4. Evidence of Success - In this academic year, a total of 17000/- Rs. were distributed to 17 meritorious students of the college in their final year of graduation from various departments and subjects to recognize their accomplishments and to promote the same in future.

5. Problems Encountered and Resources Required - It is challenging to select economically deprived students, and due to limited financial resources, it is not feasible to assist every needy student in order to uplift students' academic performance.
